



## Service Employees Opportunity Endowed Scholarship

The Service Employees Opportunity Scholarship recognizes the contributions of service employees to the well-being of the University of Washington. It offers UW scholarships to service employees and their family members.

You can participate in this scholarship in one of two ways:

1. If you are a food service, laundry, or custodial employee with at least five years of service to any UW location, you or a member of your family can apply for this scholarship for use at all UW campuses. The deadline for application is May 30, 2025, and is made through Office of Student Financial Aid. 2. You may contribute to this scholarship fund. Contributions can be of any amount and given one time or over a period of time.
